## FREE Webinar: EPS Recycling Made Easy

Join us on Wednesday, June 28 from 11:30 am to 12:30 pm to learn about EPS recycling in Omaha. EPS foam (expanded polystyrene - #6 plastic), mistakenly called Styrofoam®, is not widely accepted by recycling companies. Nationwide, EPS is only recycled at an average rate of 15%.

Plastilite Corporation, a manufacturer of EPS coolers, is the only company in Nebraska that offers a public drop-off site for EPS coolers and packaging material, and also offers a mail-back program for U.S. residents.

Barry Kriha has been with Plastilite Corporation for nearly two years. Prior to joining them, he worked in broadcasting and the ad agency world for nearly twenty years. Born in Gibbon, Nebraska, Barry graduated from the University of Nebraska at Lincoln.
